H&R Block at Home Software Update

Calgary, Alberta – (May 14, 2010) – A recent report showed that several major certified tax software programs missed an Ontario credit for 2009. The deduction is available for taxpayers who claimed the caregiver credit for hosting an adult relative with a physical or mental infirmity.

This issue did not affect the tax software used in our more than 1,000 retail locations across Canada but it does impact H&R Block at Home users.

Though only a small percentage of Ontario residents are eligible to claim this credit, we want to ensure everyone receives their maximum refund no matter how they prepared their tax return. For taxpayers concerned about missed deductions, they can make a free Second Look appointment at an H&R Block office across Canada. A tax professional will review the return and check for any missed deductions or credits.

Our software team is working on an update for H&R Block at Home and it will be available shortly.
